Who Should Attend & Why

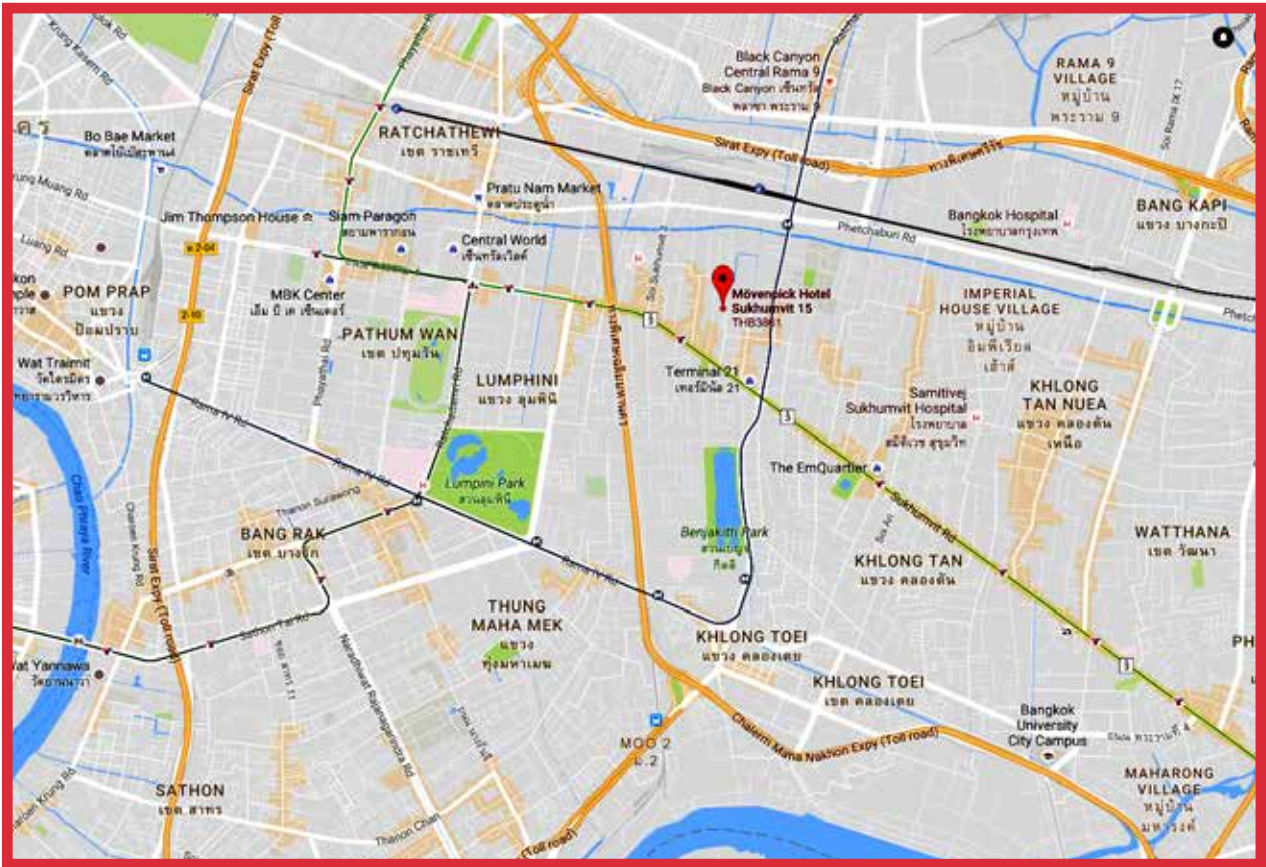
- Open to all security practitioners, Thai and expats, from those starting out in the industry to senior managers.
